- Clinical Cases
 - A tabletop presentation to the membership
- Prospective Track
 - Affiliates with less than 10 years of experience or by choice. 10-12 cases are followed over 3 years and 6 cases are presented as finished cases
- Retrospective Track
 - Affiliates with 10 years or more experience. 6 finished cases are presented within 6 months
- Research Thesis
 - An original project of literature review. The final paper is reviewed and a summary presentation is given orally to the membership
- Biennial Meeting
 - Each affiliate must attend the national meeting at least once prior to obtaining active member status
